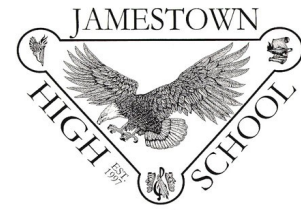

The New Horizons Governor's School for Science and Technology

The Governor's School is a two-year, half-day program for 11th and 12th graders. Admission to the program is highly competitive. Students select either the engineering strand, the biological science strand, or the scientific programming strand. Students receive weighted dual enrollment credit at Christopher Newport University.

Williamsburg-James City County Honors Seal Diploma

Students who successfully complete the academic requirements, community service project, and individual honors research project receive the WJCC Honors Seal.

The requirements include:

- Complete five or more AP courses in three content areas including AP exams
- Complete a four-course sequence in one global language
- Design and complete an in-depth Honors Research Project
- Design and complete a Community Service Project of 25 or more hours
