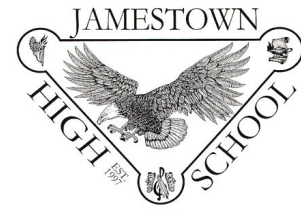

School and Community

Jamestown High School is a state-of-the-art public high school accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. One of three high schools serving the Williamsburg-James City County area of Virginia, Jamestown is located in a suburban community of 70,000 residents. Williamsburg is home to The College of William & Mary and Thomas Nelson Community College.

Information Related to 2019-2020 School Year and Closures due to COVID-19

During the Spring of the 2019-2020 school year, WJCC closed on March 13, 2020 to switch to virtual learning in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. While WJCC did not reopen to in-person instruction during the close of the school year, options were made available to students to accommodate for the changes in the learning environment. High school students were given the option to earn a "P" as their final grade in place of the letter grade earned. Students could choose this on a course to course basis. In addition to this accommodation, students were permitted to earn an "I" for a course and allowed time into the summer and fall semester to complete the work and earn a passing grade. All grades of "I" will be adjusted to the appropriate letter grade in the fall semester of the 2020-2021 school year, if not sooner.

Class rank is based on the grades earned in courses for which credit is awarded. The grade point average is the sum of quality points for grades in completed courses divided by the number of credits attempted. Grade point average and rank are recomputed each semester.

The Governor's School is a two-year, half-day program for 11th and 12th graders. Admission to the program is highly competitive. Students select either the engineering strand, the biological science strand, or the scientific programming strand. Students receive weighted dual enrollment credit at Christopher Newport University.
