Graduation Rehearsal – Rehearsal is scheduled for **June 12th** at 9:00 a.m. at Jamestown in the gym. Attendance is mandatory. The gym will be set up similar to Kaplan Arena and students will practice marching in, know where their seat is, and the names will be read to make sure the pronunciation is correct.

Graduation Tickets - will be distributed at rehearsal. Each student will receive **15 tickets**. If you need more than that, students should see Mrs. Sharp at rehearsal. There is no charge for tickets.

Graduation - June 14th at 5:00 p.m., Kaplan Arena at William and Mary. Students should arrive at 4:00 and check in when they arrive. The ceremony usually lasts about 1 1/2 hours and will be live streamed for anyone that cannot attend. Handicap seating is available on the floor of the arena and no prior arrangements need to be made. The handicap entrance is on the ground level on the right side of the building. One person may accompany the person needing assistance.
