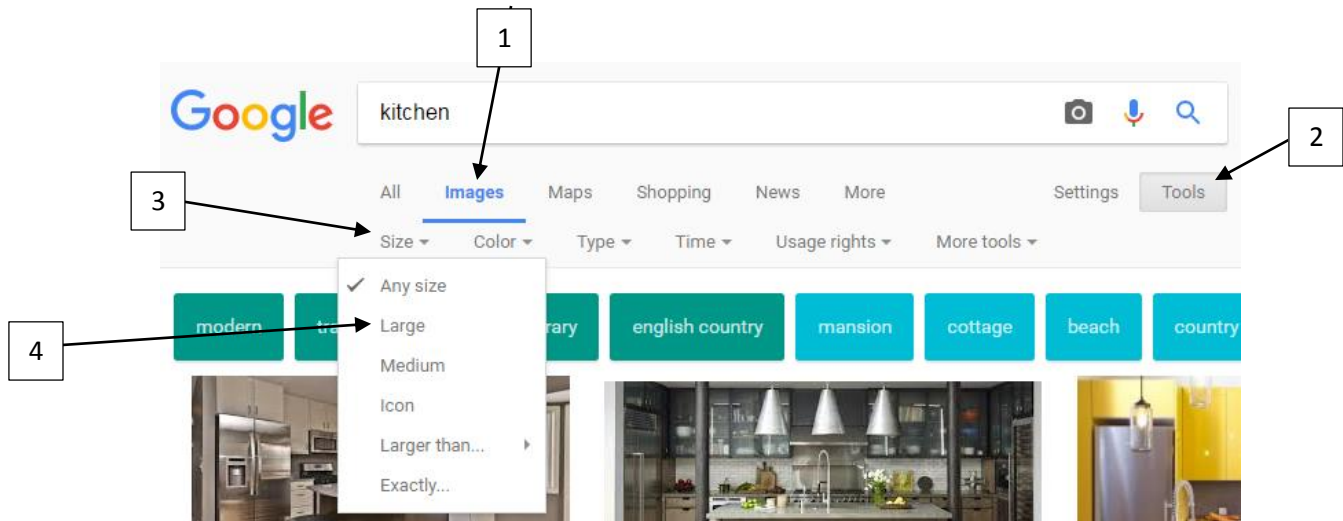
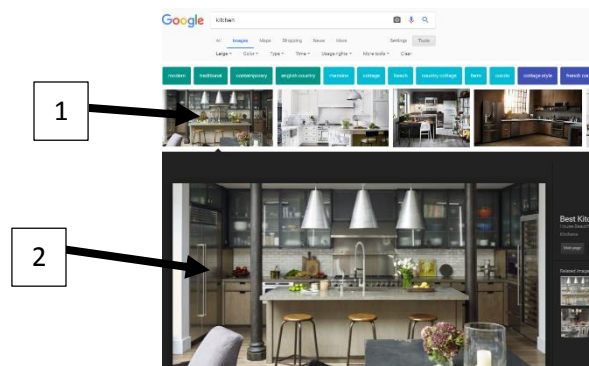


Finding background pictures

- 1) Search for a background image in Google. Select **Images** -> click on **Tools**-> Click on **Size** -> Select **Large**



- 2) Click on the picture you like, and it will open in a larger window. Right click on the larger image to save it.



Paint Directions

- 1) Click the "Start" button in the bottom left corner of the screen. In the search box type "paint" and open the program.
- 2) Once paint opens, click on the "paste" button in the upper left corner and choose "paste from". Navigate to where your picture is saved. This picture should now show in "Paint".
- 3) Repeats steps 1 and 2 for your second picture.
- 4) Once both pictures are in paint, click on the picture that you are cropping. Click on the word "select" in the upper left corner and a drop down box should appear. Choose "Free-form selection."
- 5) Use your mouse to trace around the portion of your picture that you want to capture.
- 6) Once you release the mouse, a square will appear around the line you drew. Do a right click inside the square and choose copy.
- 7) Now go to the picture you want to use as a background. Right click on the picture and choose "paste". You will see the picture you copied along with an extra white background. Click on the word "select" in the upper left corner. A drop down box should appear. Choose "Transparent selection". Now the white background should disappear and you can move your selection to where you want it. (Once you click off the picture, you will not be able to move it. If this happens delete it, and re-paste it).
