

## What Do Students Read in WJCC High School English Classes?

- English 9 students read
  - William Shakespeare's *Romeo and Juliet*
  - Homer's *The Odyssey*
  - Harper Lee's *To Kill a Mockingbird*
- Intensified English 9 students additionally read
  - Charles Dickens's *Great Expectations*
  
- English 10 students read
  - William Golding's *Lord of the Flies*
  - A selected Shakespearean play
  - Sophocles's *Antigone*
  - a variety of poetry
- Intensified English 10 students additionally read
  - Charles Dickens's *A Tale of Two Cities*
  
- 11<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in American Studies, Advanced American Studies, and Honors English 11 read a variety of classic, canonical American literature in a diversity of genres (poems, novels, plays, essays, speeches, and short stories).
  
- 12<sup>th</sup> grade students enrolled in English 12, Advanced World Literature, and AP English Literature read
  - William Shakespeare's *Macbeth* and/or *Hamlet*
  - a variety of other British and/or world literature
- AP English Language students read
  - a variety of non-fiction writings
