### Mark Your Calendar

This school year we will offer three different ways for you to get the extra SOL (Standards of Learning) help you want. You can attend one of these sessions or all of these sessions. The choice is up to you! Keep in mind, you need to pass your SOL tests in order to graduate. Incoming freshmen need 5 SOLs to graduate and sophomores through seniors need 6 (Standard Diploma) or 9 (Advanced Diploma) SOLs to graduate. ### After School Academic Boot Camp
