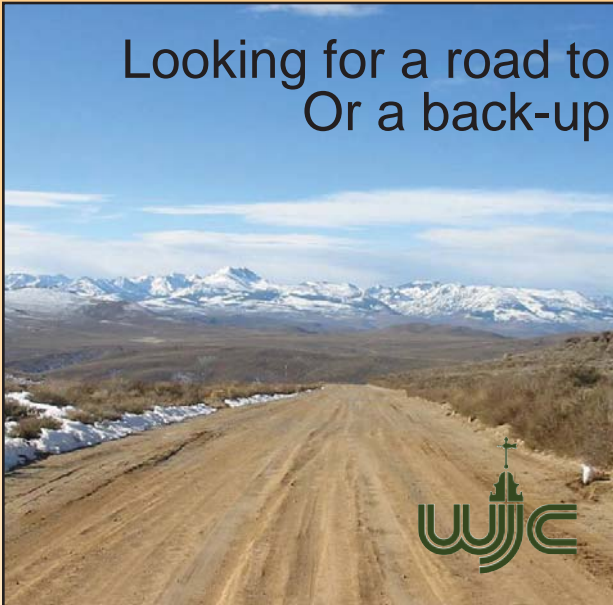


# Looking for a road to life-rewarding work? Or a back-up plan in addition to college?



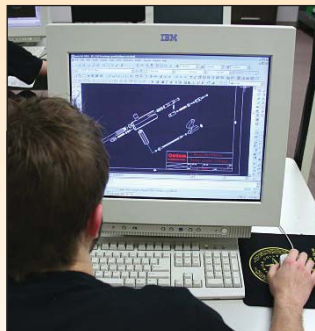
**Career Pathways** can get you the skills you need on your way to gainful, life-rewarding work. W-JCC offers eight exciting pathways to follow, with even more being developed.

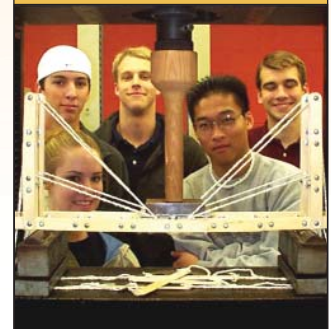

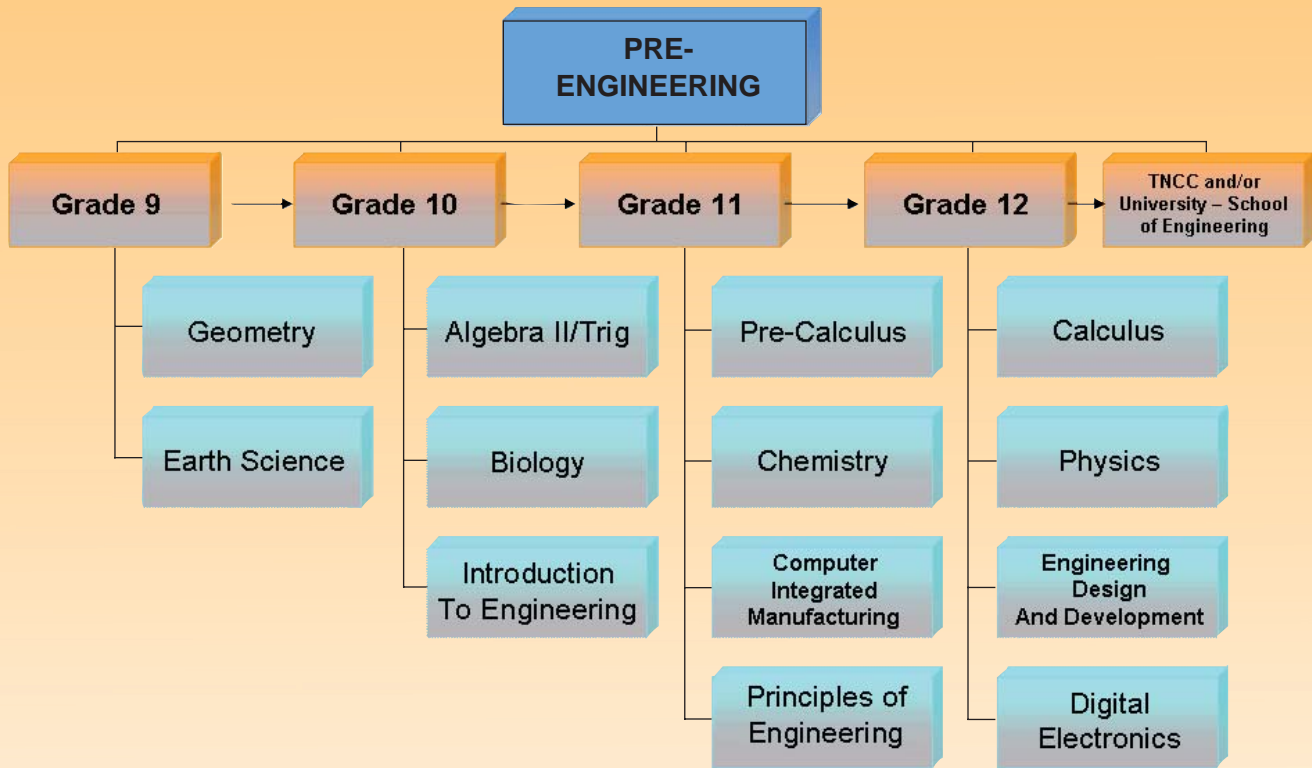

Be sure to consider Career Pathways when planning for your successful career. To find out more, ask your guidance counselor.

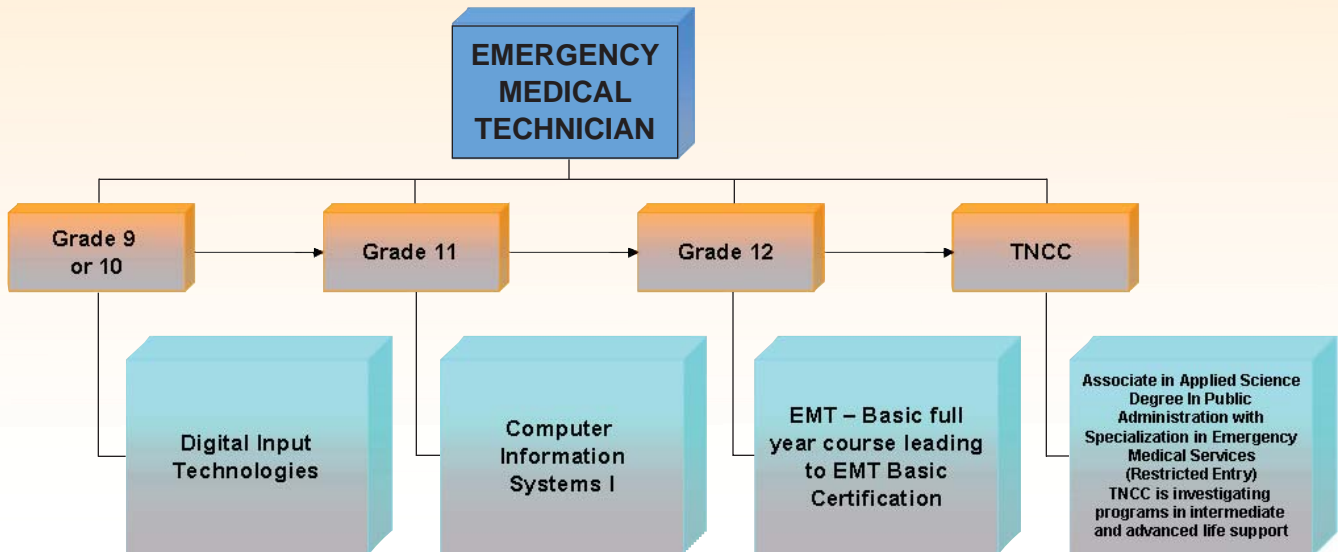

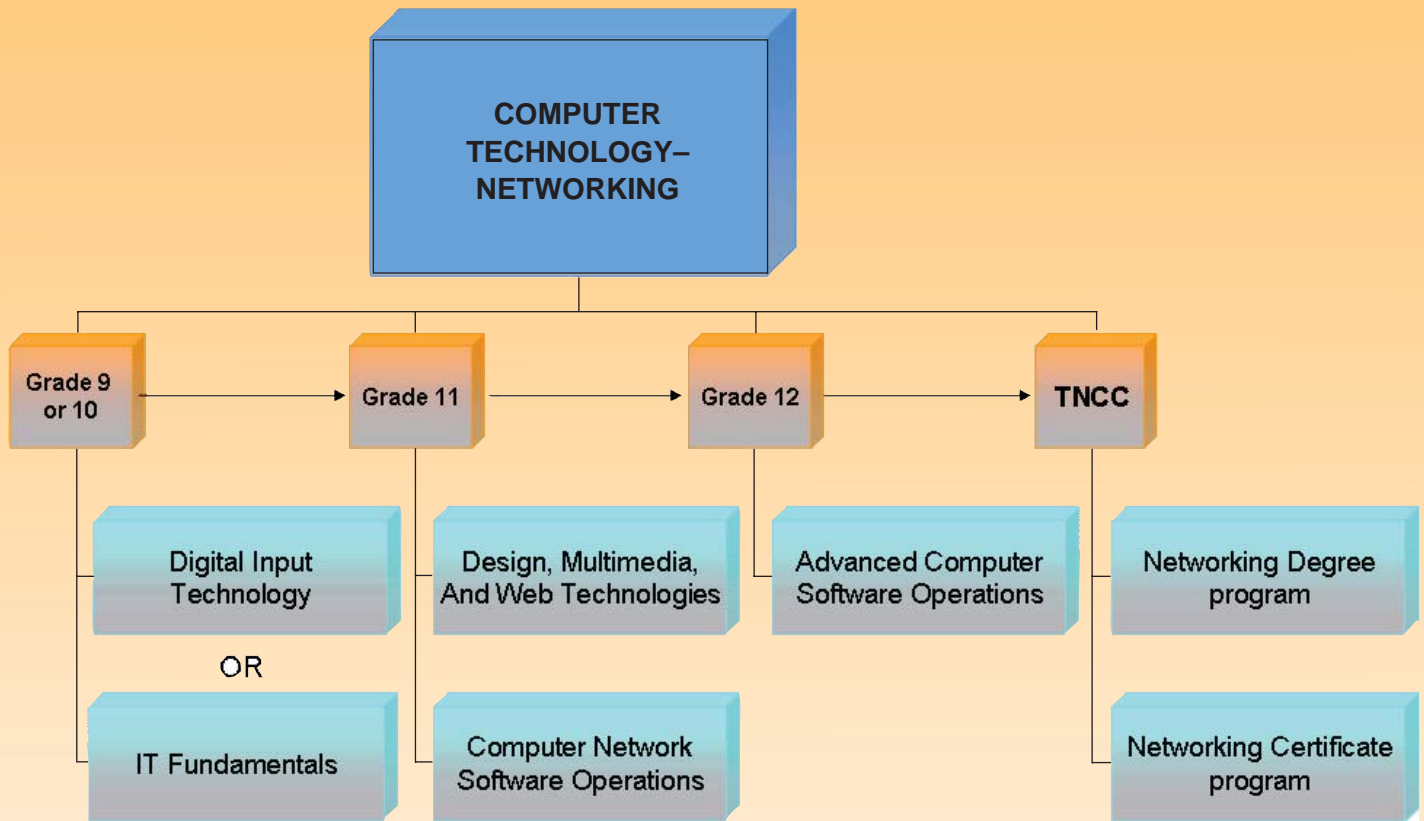
# CAREER PATHWAY TO PRE-ENGINEERING



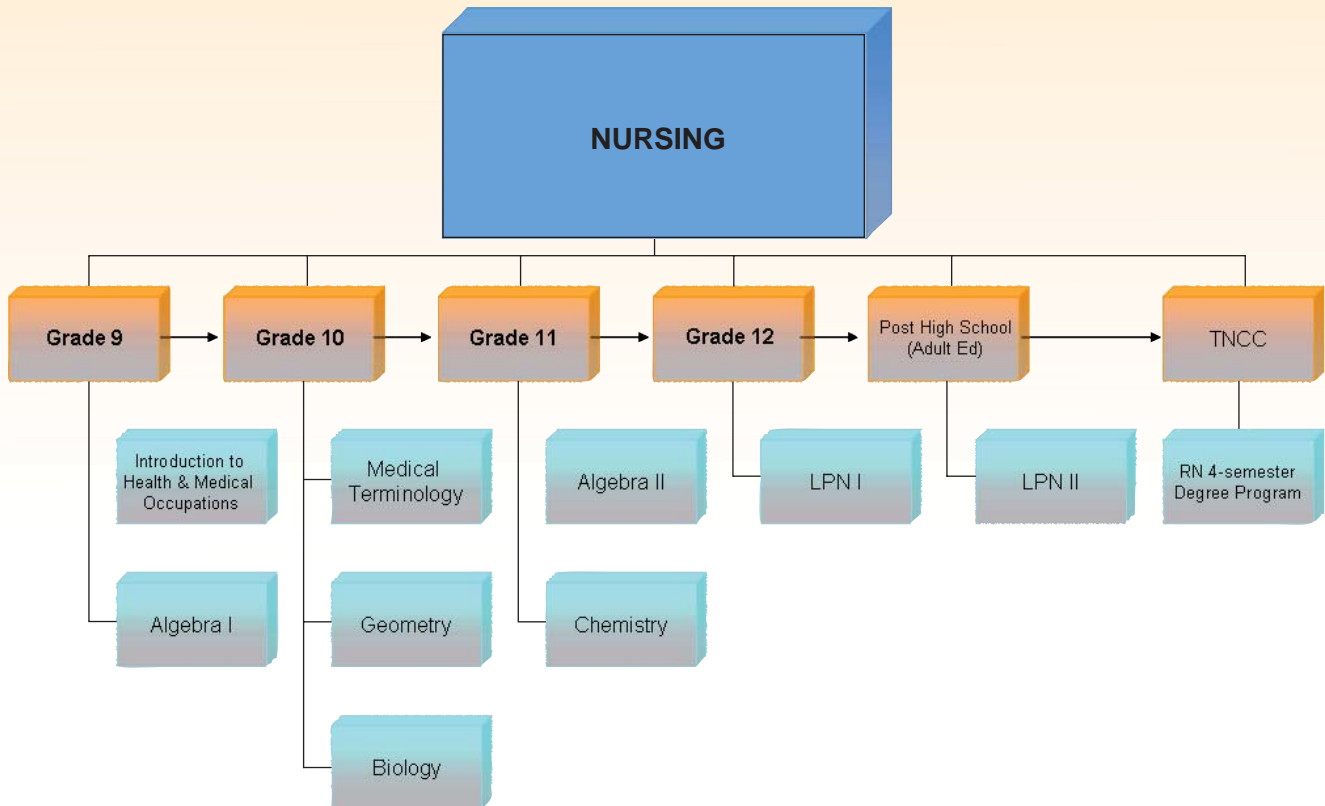
# CAREER PATHWAY TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN



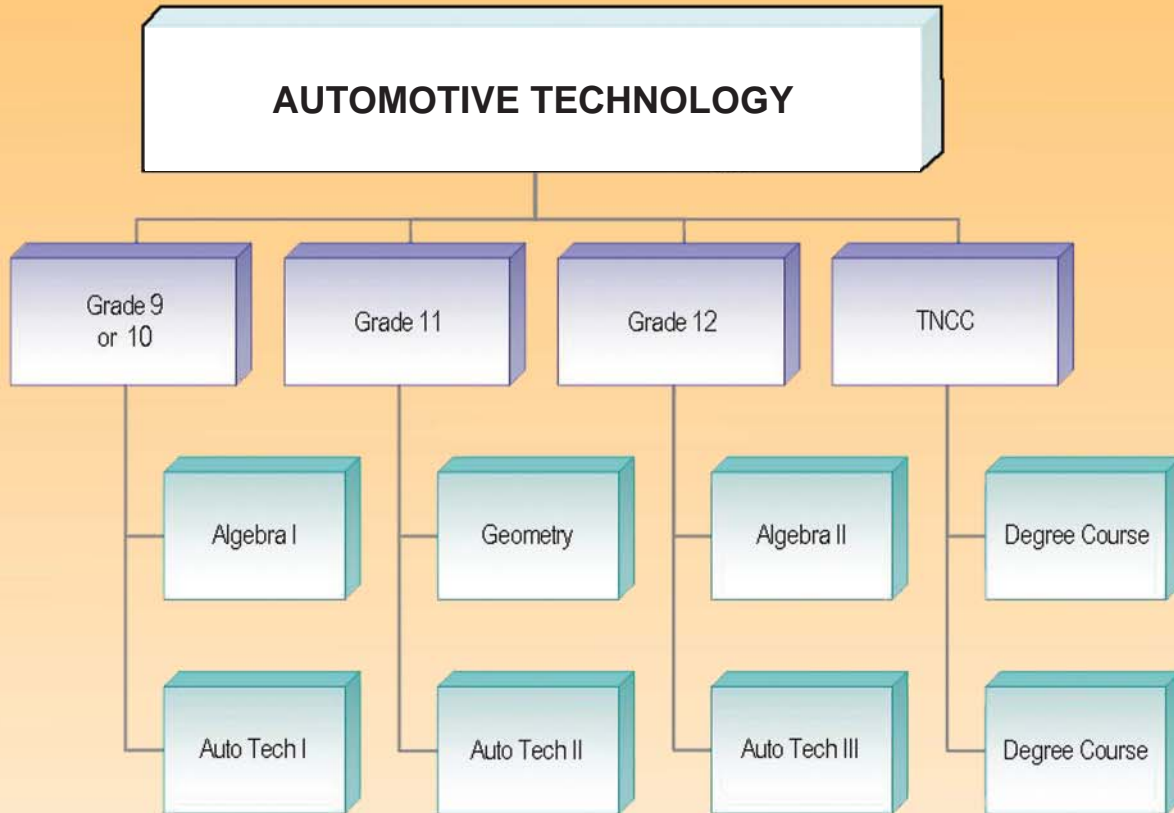

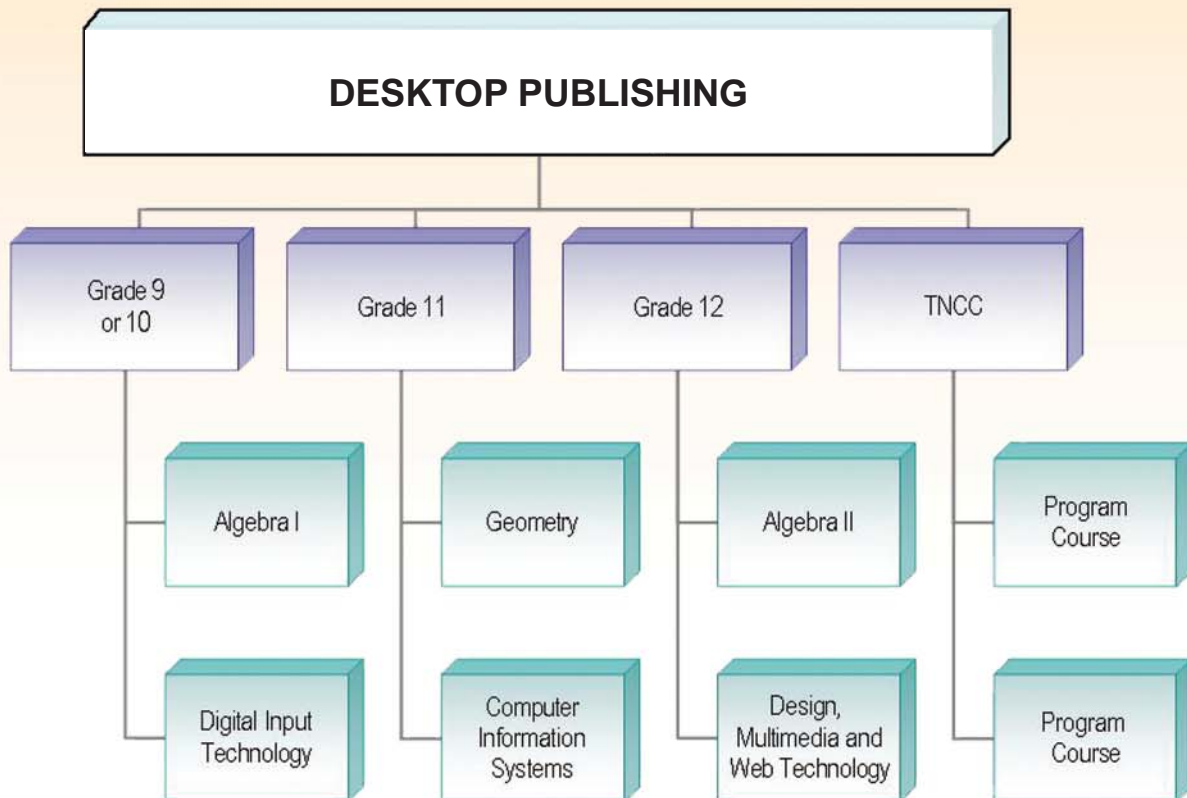

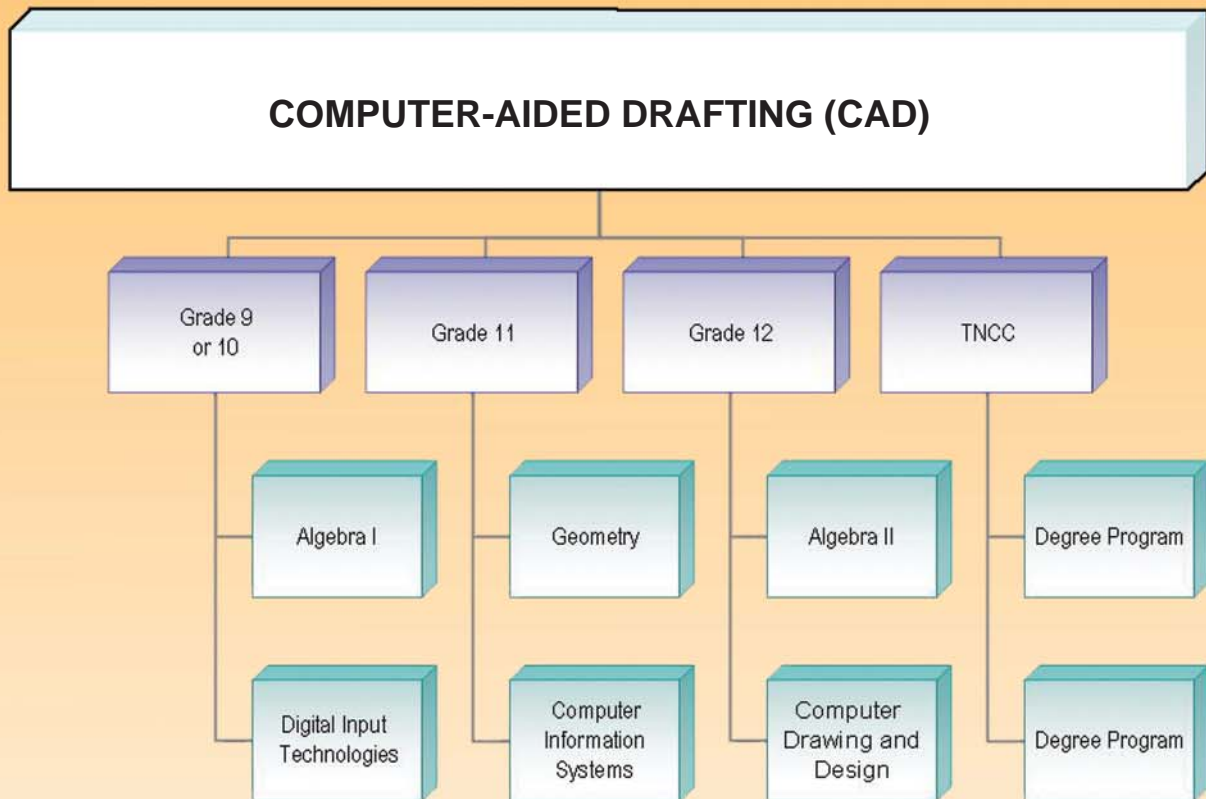
