## PREPOSITION POSITION

**Purpose:** Students will use concrete objects to show locations of prepositions.

**Suggested Grade Level**: PK-K

**Math SOL:** Geometry K.12

## **Equipment/Materials Needed:**

1. Scarves, bean bags, discs, cones or other colored objects (at least 1 for each student in class)

## **Directions:**

- 1. Scatter objects around the playing area.
- 2. On "go" signal, have each student move around the area using a specific physical activity, i.e. walk, jog, skip, etc.
- 3. On the "stop" signal, have students go to one of the objects in the playing area.
- 4. Instruct students to pick up the item by which they stopped.
- 5. Call out prepositional locations for students to follow. Example: Place the item over you or stand over the item; place the item through your legs; put the items under your feet; place the item beside you, behind you; stand on the left of your item, the right; place the item above you.

## **Modifications/Variations:**

- 1. Teacher can place a variety of items out with multiples of the same item and do the same activity, i.e. stand behind a yellow cone, in front of a green scarf, etc.
- 2. Have students perform different physical activities and go to a different item each time.

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
