Tips for Being A Successful Online Learner:

- Have a separate workspace dedicated to schoolwork. Consider a space where you can participate live with your class and your teacher on Zoom without being distracted, or distracting others.
- Post your teacher’s office hours and best method of communication so it is easy to find when needed.
- Keep a sheet of any username and passwords needed for your classwork in your work area so they are easy to reference.
- Check for emails regularly to be sure you stay current on classroom happenings.
- Know and plan for your assignment due dates.
- Stay current and on time with all of your assignments.
- Be sure to check the Vue gradebook regularly.
- Login to your ParentVue (K-3) or StudentVue (4-5) account every school day.
- Review and complete the “To Do” list at the top of your teacher’s website each day.
- Regularly participate in live classroom sessions to stay actively engaged with your class and your learning. If you are unable to attend a live session, be sure to watch the recorded session.
- Complete the instruction and assignments in the order in which they are assigned.
- Speak up when you need assistance. No question is too big or too small when you are trying to make progress with your learning.
- Work hard to learn and understand the material.
- Do your own work.
- Having a backpack or school bag that is dedicated to holding your laptop and other materials will be helpful if needing to work in an alternate location.
- For optimal learning, you should be able to sit straight with your computer at eye level so you do not have to crouch down. Your feet should rest comfortably on the ground.
